DIRECTIONS

BY TRAIN: From Grand Central Station, take the Metro North Hudson Line to Ossining or Croton-Harmon station. From there, taxis are always waiting at the station.

DRIVING FROM THE SOUTH: Taconic State Parkway North to Pinesbridge Road exit. Turn left off the exit. The entrance to Maryknoll is 2.2 miles on the right.

DRIVING FROM THE NORTH: Taconic State Parkway South to Rt. 134 exit. Follow Rt. 134 to Rt. 9A (South). Get off at Ryder Road exit. Turn right off exit. The entrance to Maryknoll is 0.5 miles on the left.
